Beth Ireland demonstrates 'Turning a Box'

Beth Ireland came beating the drum—for her present project 'Turning around America.' As part of this project she is intend on teaching all America about the rewards and self-fulfillment of developing wood turning and, to the further extent, of teaching people to derive artistic achievement through turning. Her present work is to 'Plant a Seed' with regard to woodturning. Her goal is that of having as many people as possible realize the possibility of turning, no matter how small and simple the project might be.

Ms. Ireland continued by giving a presentation on her turnings developed over the years, and presented the causative factors that brought about her particular artistic type of turning.



The third part of her talk was a demonstration on how to develop a box for turning, and then turn the box. Starting with a simple, small piece of soft wood,

she went to the band saw and cut one end completely from the piece. This small end would be the top of the box. She continued by cutting two sides from



the remaining larger piece. The middle piece, after the two sides were cut away, will be the middle of the box. The center portion of this piece was cut out. A tenon was cut at the top for the lid.

Then the three pieces, the two sides and the middle section, were glued together just as they were before being cut. Now the box is ready to be turned, or the surface carved to final shape.


